ADVANCED FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING PRACTICE AND THEORY (20 credits)

The module will introduce students to the advanced topics in financial reporting and financial accounting

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (20 credits)

Through the provision of an assessed placement, the aim of this module is to provide students with a learning experience which will help them to bridge the gap between their current academic studies and the future professional life post-graduation. The requirements are for the student to spend a minimum of 40 hours in the placement itself, and that the type of placement be such that the student is capable of meeting the learning objectives of the module. As part of the experience, students will be required to reflect on their respective strengths and weaknesses in an employment context, identify potential areas for personal and professional development and reflect (a) on what they have learnt about themselves upon their return from their placement and
